Do what is expected and do it the best you can. Make good choices. It is your decision/choice to move to Step 1.
Consequences = fair, predictable, reasonable, enforceable, logical. Mistake and Retake

Step 1: Teacher (T) to Student (S): "Step One, talking out without raising your hand (or other behavior)."

After 5 mins: T: "Why are you on Step One?" S. Response: "I interfered with _____'s learning (safety or wellbeing) by _____."

T: "Do you need more time?" If S. says "Yes.", then T: "I'll come back later."

Step 2: If S. does not behave properly during Step 1. T. walks over and says: "Step 2, (state exact behavior)."

S. stands up facing away from the activity. 5 mins. T: "What did you do to choose Step 2?" ("Why are you on Step 2?")

S. Response. T: "Do you need more time?" S. Response
